<u>Building and Grounds:</u> The Board was informed that the 2023 Environmental Grant through the county is due in January and the 2022 application for the exhaust system would be submitted again as advised by the administrator. The 2022 grant was awarded to the park, however we were unable to complete the project by the October 31, 2022 deadline due to delays in the production of the equipment to be installed.

Ideas for the 2023 PEP grant were discussed which mostly included the replacement of the two gazebos in the park. The park will qualify for \$15,000.

In looking at future projects, the Director inquired if the Board would be interested in learning more about solar energy which would include the addition of panels to buildings which would be covered by grant money while offsetting power costs. There would also be a credit from the federal government which could be used for any project.
